MINI GRANT DETAILS:

- Grant Amount: **\$500**
- Number of Grants Available: **12** (distributed by county)
- Application due date: **Friday, February 17, 2012 @ 5pm**
- Applicants will be notified by Wednesday, February 29th if they received a mini grant

GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Submit a completed application form (attached)
- Submit a Budget Proposal
- Define administrative contact (this is the person who will handle all membership registration details, monthly reporting, scheduling communication with the CEVA office, etc)
- Email application to joeb@columbiaempirevolleyball.com

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Any parent, coach, club director or volunteer who is interested in developing junior boys' volleyball
- It is highly encouraged that interested parties within the same county coordinate efforts and submit one mini grant application

WHAT CRITERIA WILL BE USED FOR EVALUATING APPLICATIONS?

- People or counties who are already actively promoting/encouraging participation and have shown a demonstrated effort this year to grow junior boys' volleyball
- Applications which are well thought out, articulate and reasonable – although the mini grant application is for spring 2012, it will take many years to develop a sustainable junior boys' volleyball program
- Budgets targeting sustainable investment – investing in things like uniforms, balls, ball carts, etc which will last over many years

HOW WILL THE GRANTS FUNDS BE DISPERSED?

- Reimbursement grant - receipts must be submitted by May 31, 2012 for reimbursement
- CEVA will also provide 1 complimentary adult membership & background screening per county awarded a mini grant

EXPECTATIONS IF AWARDED GRANT:

- Bring in *at least* 12 new junior boys' players in your county
- Monthly reports submitted to CEVA office (form will be provided)
- Every participant is a registered CEVA member
- Every adult participant has completed USA Volleyball required background screening.
- Every adult participant completes a basic coaches certification program (IMPACT)
- Participation on weekly conference call
- Post regularly to the CEVA Boys' Facebook page
- Provide CEVA with brief articles including photos for posting on our blog
